**NOT IN OUR TOWN: THE TWIN PORTS RESIST ICE**

Duluth, MN – [December 10, 2025] The Twin Ports Rapid Response Team formed because our community, especially our immigrant neighbors, family, friends, and coworkers, are under attack. The Twin Ports Rapid Response Team started meeting in mid-2025 as volunteers committed to witnessing, nonviolently disrupting, and defending our community's right to live without fear.

In response to escalating attacks on immigrants in Minnesota and across the U.S., the Twin Ports Rapid Response Team is convening a press event to publicly announce our group, work, and beliefs to the broader community. We invite the community to join us as we mobilize our emergency response network, serve as witnesses to immigration enforcement actions, uphold the rights of immigrants, and spread awareness of whistles as a growing way to push back against ICE. This work connects us with communities all around the country who are coming together to protect one another.
